This hands-on cooking experience is perfect for the youngest chefs. Come learn to create a variety of simple, healthy recipes. All recipes will be heat-free and easy to re-create at home. With guidance, budding chefs will learn to transform simple ingredients into tasty snacks, beverages, entrees, and treats.
